Itinerary Option 01 -

Stockholm, Sweden:

Stavanger, Norway:

Similar to Bergen, Stavanger has a mild and wet climate influenced by its coastal location.

Lofoten Islands, Norway:

Winter (December to February): Cold temperatures ranging from -1°C to 3°C (30°F to 37°F). Snowfall is common, and daylight hours are significantly reduced. The Northern Lights are often visible during clear nights.

Tromsø, Norway:

Spring: Temperatures range from -2° C to 5° C (28°F to 41°F) in March, gradually warming to 0°C to 8°C (32°F to 46°F) in May. Increasing daylight hours.

Summer: Tromsø experiences a relatively mild summer compared to other parts of Norway, with temperatures averaging between 7°C to 15°C (45°F to 59°F) from June to August. The "midnight sun" phenomenon occurs, with 24-hour daylight during the peak of summer.

Autumn: Temperatures start to drop, ranging from 2° C to 9° C (36° F to 48° F) in September, cooling further to -2° C to 4° C (28° F to 39° F) in November. Increasing chances of seeing the Northern Lights.

Winter: Cold temperatures with averages between -4°C to -1°C (25°F to 30°F) in December, January, and February. Snowfall is common, and daylight hours are significantly reduced. Ideal for viewing the Northern Lights.
